**Research stay at the Madrid Institute for Advanced Study and the DFK Paris**

Within the framework of the collaboration agreement between, the Deutsches Forum für Kunstgeschichte (DFK Paris), Casa de Velázquez, and the Madrid Institute for Advanced Study (MIAS), a research stay of six consecutive months, divided between Paris (three months) and Madrid (three months), is offered to develop a post-doctoral research project in the field of Art History (Latin America, 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries).

MIAS, the first institute for advanced studies in the Iberian Peninsula, as well as in the Spanish-American area, co-funded by the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid and Casa de Velázquez, promotes the development of innovative projects in an environment conducive to scientific debate. It enhances interdisciplinarity and prioritizes research of excellence in Humanities, Social and Legal Sciences, with a transversal perspective from the Iberian world to the global dimension.

DFK Paris is an independent Art History research institute. Located in the heart of Paris, it is programmatically conceived as a "forum", a place for exchange between specialists from all over the world. Here, French and German-speaking scholarly traditions enter into a fruitful dialogue with international trends and become the starting point for innovative and interdisciplinary research on the Art of both countries in a global context. The scholarship is part of a research programme that focuses on the artistic relations between France and Latin America.

## Requirements

The candidate must:

- Be in possession of a doctoral degree issued by an institution in a Latin American country before December 31, 2019. This can be verified with a photocopy of the doctoral degree.
- Present a research project that will specifically and explicitly benefit from the stay. The project must be related to the research orientations of MIAS and DFK Paris, and must be no more than 6 pages, including a selective bibliography, with a minimum font size of 11 points and single spaced.
- Provide a CV mentioning his/her major publications (maximum 5 pages with a minimum font size of 11 points and single spaced).
- Provide a photocopy of valid passport.
- Optionally, provide one or two letters of reference that can support the his/her potential and qualifications.
- Have permanently resided in a non-European country for at least 6 months prior to the deadline for this call (affidavit required).

Failure to comply with any of the conditions listed will terminate the processing of the application.

## Selection process

- Digital submission of the complete documentation to the following e-mail addresses: [contact@madrid-ias.eu](mailto:contact@madrid-ias.eu) and [stipendien@dfk-paris.org](mailto:stipendien@dfk-paris.org)
- Evaluation of the projects by the international selection committee, composed of MIAS and DFK Paris representatives.
- The call for applications will be launched at the same time as the annual MIAS call (27/10/2022 - 30/11/2022), so that the stay can take place in the following academic year.

## Criteria for selection

- The quality of the candidate's scientific dossier
- The quality and future potential of the research project.
- The congruency of the project with the research orientations of MIAS and DFK Paris.

### **MIAS support**

- MIAS will contribute to the costs of international transatlantic transport up to a maximum amount of 550 euros.
- The beneficiary researcher will receive a sum of 1,000 euros per month.
- MIAS will provide accommodation for the researcher in the Casa de Velázquez facilities, in accordance with the conditions set out in the institution's internal regulations.

### **Deutsches Forum für Kunstgeschichte in Paris support**

- The recipient researcher will receive an instalment grant of 2,000€ per month during his/her three-month stay in Paris. A family supplement of 500€/month may be granted provided it is mentioned in the grant application. The grant should cover all costs related to the stay in Paris.

### **Resident's obligations**

The resident at MIAS and DFK Paris commits to:

- Take part in MIAS's intellectual life, in the lunches or seminars of the academic staff in residence at MIAS.
- Take part in the DFK's intellectual life.
- Contribute to the dissemination of the activities carried out at MIAS and DFK Paris.
- Specify in the publications resulting from the stay that these have been carried out during the stay at MIAS and DFK Paris.
- Submit a final report of activities to both MIAS and DFK Paris.
- Develop research work in Madrid and in Paris.
- Respect the regulations of MIAS and DFK Paris (Stipendienordnung).
- Provide proof of medical insurance valid in Spain and France for the duration of the stay in Madrid and Paris.

**Note:** The project carried out during the stay must be in line with the submitted proposal.

With regard to the health situation, some flexibility in the dates for the stays will be accepted. However, the stay must take place during the Sept. 2023 / July 2024 academic year.
